NOTICE OF STAFF PUBLIC MEETING

(November 5, 2001)

The Federal Energy Regulatory Commission (Commission) has issued an Advance Notice of Proposed Rulemaking seeking comments on a standard generator interconnection agreement and procedure that would be applicable to all public utilities that own, operate, or control transmission facilities under the Federal Power Act.

The Commission has directed staff to try to develop a consensus on the standard interconnection agreement and procedure. In the continuing effort to reach consensus, the Commission staff will hold public meetings on Wednesday, November 7, 2001, to discuss the scope of interconnection rights, and on Thursday, November 8, 2001, to discuss interconnection studies issues. Both meetings are scheduled to begin at 9 am. The location for the meeting on November 7 will be announced on the Commission's Internet site at http://www.ferc.gov/electric/gen_inter.htm. The meeting on November 8 will take place in the Commission Meeting Room at the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission, 888 First St. NE, Washington, DC.
