**ORDER CONVENING ORAL ARGUMENT**

**(Issued November 27, 2001)**

As proposed, an oral argument on the issues raised by the motion to compel filed by Pinnacle West Companies on November 21, 2001, shall be convened at 1:00 P.M. in a Commission hearing room on November 28, 2001. As a possible solution to this dispute, the participants shall promptly discuss the feasibility of the ISO identifying from the transcripts of tapes provided to ISO witness O'Neill those portions that bear on the requested data and making available those portions of the tapes to the movants at a convenient location. By 11:00 A.M. on November 28, 2001, the participants shall advise me if this suggestion proves to be an acceptable solution to the controversy and, if so, I will deem the motion to compel withdrawn and cancel the oral argument.
