Standardization of Generator Interconnection  
Agreements and Procedures

Notice of Staff Public Meeting

(January 3, 2002)

In October 2001, the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission (Commission) issued an Advance Notice of Proposed Rulemaking seeking comments on a standard generator interconnection agreement and procedure that would be applicable to all public utilities that own, operate, or control transmission facilities under the Federal Power Act. As part of this process, on January 11, 2002, the Generator Interconnection Coalition<sup>1</sup> (Coalition) will file a single consensus document that will include a standard connection agreement and a standard interconnection procedures document.

The Commission staff will hold public meetings on Thursday, January 17, 2002, and Friday, January 18, 2002, to discuss and clarify the consensus document. The meetings are scheduled to take place each day from 9 a.m. to 5 p.m in the Commission Meeting Room at the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission, 888 First St. NE, Washington, DC.
