**ORDER GRANTING BONNEVILLE POWER ADMINISTRATION'S  
MOTION FOR LEAVE TO FILE INITIAL BRIEF OUT OF TIME**

(Issued October 10, 2002)

1. On October 9, 2002, counsel for the Bonneville Power Administration (BPA) filed a motion requesting leave to file its Initial Brief in the above-captioned proceeding out of time, in accordance with 18 C.F.R. §§ 385.504, 385.2008(b) (2002).
2. Per my Order Adopting Procedural Schedule issued on August 28, 2002, I required initial briefs addressing non-APX issues to be filed by October 4, 2002. On October 4, 2002, BPA served the Parties in this proceeding through ListServ with BPA's Initial Brief after submitting the brief to the Commission through its electronic filing system. Even though BPA's submission was accepted by the electronic filing system on October 4, 2002, it was subsequently rejected on October 8, 2002. BPA re-filed its Initial Brief with the Commission's Office of the Secretary on October 8, 2002. On October 9, 2002, BPA filed a Motion for Leave to File Initial Brief Out of Time. In this motion, BPA represented that no party in this proceeding will be affected by the granting of leave to file the initial brief out of time.
