Dear Senator Allen:

I would like your help resolving a problem I'm having with the following Federal agency:

FERC and Federal D.O.T. on Dominion Gas Pipeline

My problem is (please state highlights, giving dates and background information):

Federal D.O.T. provides design requirements and these can be found in part 192 - Transportation of natural or other gas by pipeline: Minimum Federal Safety Standards. By their class definitions, my property will be class 3. Recognize that class 4 carries a higher construction standard. Class 4 will require 2 1/2 times wall thickness as than class 3. I consider this discriminatory as that the Federal government recognizes safety problems and takes steps to better protect the people who live in class 4. I am as concerned about my families safety as anyone who would live in class 4. I don't believe that anyone should get a higher safety standard than anyone else.
