ORDER OF CHIEF JUDGE ESTABLISHING  
SETTLEMENT JUDGE PROCEDURES

(Issued July 22, 2003)

1. At the prehearing conference held before Presiding Judge Harfeld on July 17, 2003, the parties requested that the 17 QF proceedings now part of these proceedings be separated into three distinct groups and that settlement judge procedures be instituted for each of the groups. The parties unanimously requested that Judge Nancy be appointed the settlement judge in these proceedings.
2. The Chief Judge agrees that the appointment of a settlement judge in this proceeding will assist the parties in exploring all avenues for achieving a possible settlement of the disputed issues. Accordingly, Administrative Law Joseph R. Nancy is hereby appointed as the settlement judge to convene a settlement conference, to explore the possibility of settlement, to discuss the differences among the parties, and in general to conduct the settlement negotiations. All parties to the settlement negotiations are directed to have principals with authority to negotiate and approve settlement terms.
3. The settlement judge is directed to report the progress of the negotiations to the Chief Judge, together with his views on the prospects for settlement and his recommendations for further settlement procedures every thirty days.
