ERRATA NOTICE

(Issued June 9, 2004)

On May 28, 2004, the Commission issued an Order Conditionally Accepting June Annual Allocation for Commonwealth Edison Zone in Docket No. ER04-742-000 (May 28 Order). 107 FERC ¶ 61,223.

The May 28 Order instituted an investigation pursuant to section 206 of the Federal Power Act. The Commission has determined that a separate docket number, Docket No. EL04-105-000 should be assigned to the section 206 investigation. Accordingly, the May 28 Order is revised as follows:

1. Docket No. EL04-105-000 is added to the caption of the order.
2. Paragraph 1 the fifth sentence is revised to read: "We are also instituting an investigation in Docket No. EL04-105-000 pursuant to section 206 of the Federal Power Act into the FTR and ARR allocation process."
3. Paragraph 47 the second sentence is revised to read: "Within 120 days of this order, PJM is required to file a response in Docket No. EL04-105-00 to the Commission's concerns that customers holding long-term firm point to point contracts are treated similarly in the FTR and ARR annual allocation process to network customers."
4. Ordering paragraph (B) is revised to read: "PJM is directed to file in Docket No. EL04-105-000 its response to the Commission's concerns with its existing FTR allocation procedure within 120 days from the date of the issuance of this order."
5. Ordering paragraph (C) is revised to read: "Pursuant to the authority contained in and subject to the jurisdiction conferred upon the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission by section 402(a) of the Department of Energy Organization Act and by the Federal Power Act, particularly section 206 thereof, and pursuant to the Commission's Rules of Practice and Procedure and the regulations under the Federal Power Act (18 C.F.R., Chapter I), a public hearing shall be held in Docket No. EL04-105-000 concerning the allocation of ARRs and FTRs, as discussed in the body of this order."

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6. The current ordering paragraph (D) is renumbered (E) and a new ordering paragraph (D) is added after current ordering paragraph (C) to read:

“(D) Any interested person desiring to be heard in the proceedings in Docket No. EL04-105-000 should file a notice of intervention or motion to intervene with the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission, 888 First Street, N.E., Washington, D.C. 20426, in accordance with Rule 214 of the Commission’s Rules of Practice and Procedure (18 C.F.R. § 385.214) within 21 days of the date PJM makes the filing directed in Paragraph (B) above.”
