ORDER OF CHIEF JUDGE TERMINATING
SETTLEMENT JUDGE PROCEDURES AND DESIGNATING
PRESIDING ADMINISTRATIVE LAW JUDGE

(Issued June 18, 2004)

1. On June 10, 2004, Settlement Judge Massey reported to the Commission and to the Chief Judge that the parties to this proceeding have not been able to reach a settlement of the issues and recommended that the Chief Judge terminate the settlement judge procedures and appoint a presiding judge to conduct the hearing. Under these circumstances, the Chief Judge hereby terminates the settlement judge procedures in Docket No.ER02-2189-001, and Settlement Judge Massey is relieved of further responsibility in this docket.
2. Pursuant to Section 11 of the Administrative Procedure Act and authority duly delegated by the Chairman of this Commission, Administrative Law Judge Judith A. Dowd is hereby designated to preside at the hearing ordered by the Commission on April 15, 2004, and at such conferences as may be scheduled herein, and to issue an Initial Decision. The hearing will be conducted in Docket No. ER02-2189-003. This proceeding is subject to Track Two of the procedural time standards for hearing cases.
