ERRATA NOTICE

(July 13, 2004)

1. On June 17, 2004, the Commission issued an "Order on Further Development of the California ISO's Market Redesign and Establishing Hearing Procedures" in the above-referenced proceeding.¹
2. In the June 17 Order, the Commission directed public utility parties providing service under existing transmission contracts (ETCs) to file certain information in Docket No. ER04-928-000 within 30 days of the date of issuance of the June 17 Order; non-jurisdictional parties were invited to do likewise on a voluntary basis.² The date that is 30 days from the issuance of the June 17 Order is July 19, 2004.³
3. The date stated in paragraph 164 of the June 17 Order, however, is July 23, 2004. The Commission intended to give parties until July 23, 2004 to file the information. Accordingly, the June 17 Order is corrected as indicated below.

- a) Paragraph 163, first sentence, should read, in relevant part, as follows:

In addition, so that the Commission has a full record before it on which to base its decision on the CAISO's proposal, public utility parties providing service under ETCs are directed to file the following information in Docket No.ER04-928-000 no later than July 23, 2004, and we invite non-jurisdictional parties to do likewise on a voluntary basis:

- b) Ordering paragraph (H) first sentence, is corrected to read as follows:

Public utility parties providing service under ETCs are directed to file information, as described above, in Docket No. ER04-928-000, no later than July 23, 2004.
