NOTICE OF EXTENSION OF TIME

(August 20, 2004)

On August 13, 2004, the Association of Oil Pipelines (AOPL) filed a motion for an extension of time for regulated oil pipeline companies to file the first two quarterly financial reports, required by Commission Orders No. 646 and 646-A, in the above-docketed proceeding. In its motion, AOPL states that the software needed to file the new quarterly Form 6-Q financial reports is not yet released for general use and the delay has made an extension of time necessary. AOPL's motion states that an extension of time will give both the Commission and the filing companies time to ensure that problems with the software are worked out and that the initial filings are properly filed.

Upon consideration, notice is hereby given that an extension of time for oil pipeline companies to file the first and second quarters of the 2004 Form 6-Q is granted to and including October 1, 2004 and October 29, 2004, respectively, as requested by AOPL.
