ORDER OF CHIEF JUDGE DESIGNATING SETTLEMENT JUDGE
AND SCHEDULING SETTLEMENT CONFERENCE

(Issued September 6, 2005)

1. On September 2, 2005, counsel for Nevada Power Company and Sierra Pacific Power Company; Public Utility District No. 1 of Snohomish County, Washington; the City of Santa Clara, California; Valley Electric Association, Metropolitan Water District of Southern California; Enron Power Marketing, Inc., Enron Energy services Inc., and Enron North America Corp.; and the Commission Trial Staff jointly requested the appointment of a settlement judge to assist them in settlement negotiations. Presiding Judge Cintron concurs in the request. The parties further requested that Judge Dowd be selected as the Settlement Judge.

2. The Chief Judge agrees that the appointment of a settlement judge in these proceedings will assist the parties in exploring all avenues for achieving a possible settlement of the disputed issues. Accordingly, Administrative Law Judge Judith A. Dowd is hereby appointed as the Settlement Judge to convene a settlement conference, explore the possibility of settlement, discuss the differences among the parties, and in general conduct the settlement negotiations. All parties to the settlement negotiations are directed to have principals present at the settlement negotiations with authority to negotiate and approve settlement terms. Judge Dowd is directed to report the progress of

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the negotiations to the Chief Judge, together with her views on the prospects for settlement and her recommendations for further settlement procedures every thirty days.

3. A settlement conference with Judge Dowd is hereby scheduled to convene at 10:00 a.m. on September 15, 2005, in a hearing room of the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission, 888 First Street, NE, Washington, DC 20426.
