ORDER ACCEPTING UNCONTESTED SETTLEMENT

(Issued December 15, 2005)

1. On October 7, 2005, Attala Transmission, LLC (Attala) and Entergy Mississippi, Inc. (EMI), jointly filed a Settlement Agreement proposing to resolve all issues in the above referenced proceeding. Comments were filed on October 13, 2005 by Trial Staff. No other comments were received. On October 27, 2005, the presiding administrative law judge certified the Settlement Agreement to the Commission as uncontested.
2. The Settlement Agreement resolves all issues that were raised with respect to the justness and reasonableness of the proposed rate for the interconnection and service charge agreement filed by Attala in this proceeding to be provided to EMI.
3. The Commission finds that the Settlement Agreement is in the public interest and is hereby approved. The rate schedules submitted as part of the settlement are in compliance with Order No. 614, FERC Statutes and Regulations, Regulations Preambles July 1996-December 2000 ¶ 31,096 (2000) and are accepted for filing as designated. The Commission's approval of this settlement does not constitute approval of, or precedent regarding, any principle or issue in this proceeding. The Commission retains the right to investigate the rates, terms, and conditions of the Settlement under the just and reasonable and not unduly discriminatory or preferential standard of section 206 of the Federal Power Act.¹
4. This order terminates Docket No. ER05-1168-000.
