NOTICE GRANTING MOTION FOR EXTENSION  
OF TIME

(December 29, 2005)

On December 28, 2005, the Edison Electric Institute (EEI) filed a motion to delay the effective date of Order No. 668<sup>1</sup> which requires EEI members and other public utilities and licensees to begin keeping new accounting records under the Uniform System of Accounts effective January 1, 2006. EEI contends that, under the timeframe set forth in Order No. 668 which was only just issued on December 16, 2005, companies would have less than two weeks to adjust their recordkeeping systems at a time when normal end-of-year closing of books and records is also taking place.

On that same date, December 28, 2005, Indicated New York Transmission Owners<sup>2</sup>, the New York Independent System Operator, Inc. and Southern California Edison Company filed in support of EEI's motion.

For good cause shown, the motion to delay the effective date of Order No. 668 is hereby granted until April 1, 2006, to give affected public utilities and licensees time to meet the requirements of Order No. 668.
